## Accessible Transportation in Las Vegas

### Accessible Transport To/From Harry Reid International Airport

- Traveling to Harry Reid International Airport?
  - Route 108, Route 109, and Centennial Express (CX) all make stops at Terminal 1's Ground Level Zero at the airport. Additionally, CX serves Terminal 3. You can reach the airport by heading to the South Strip Transit Terminal (SSTT) and taking Route 109, which will get you there in just 10-15 minutes. For trip planning, you can use the Google Transit Trip Planner on our website or download the Transit or rideRTC app.
- Arriving at Harry Reid International Airport?
  - For travelers arriving at Terminal 3 and Terminal 1, you can utilize the Airport inter-terminal shuttle to move between terminals. Route 109, located at Terminal 1, allows travelers to access the South Strip Transit Terminal and connect with other routes with only a short 15-minute trip from the bus stop.
- Purchase transit passes at the airport using the Ticket Vending Machine (TVM) located at the bus stop on Level Zero of Terminal 1. The TVM accepts all credit/debit cards or exact fares. You can also buy your pass when you board the vehicle. Please have the exact change ready.

- There is a taxi line directly outside of the baggage claim at LAS. You can ask the attendant to call a wheelchair-accessible taxi.

### Wheelchair Taxis

- Las Vegas has wheelchair-accessible taxis suitable for both manual and powered wheelchairs. These accessible taxi vans are equipped with a lowered floor and a rear liftgate for entry. Wheelchair taxis can be requested on demand and usually arrive within 15-20 minutes, if not sooner.

### The Monorail & Trams

- The Las Vegas Monorail is a 3.9-mile automated monorail located next to the Las Vegas Strip. It has a total of seven stations: MGM Grand, Horseshoe/Paris Las Vegas, Flamingo/Caesars Palace, Harrah's/The LINQ, Boingo Station at the Las Vegas Convention Center, Westgate Las Vegas, and the SAHARA Las Vegas Station. The Monorail starts at the SAHARA Las Vegas Station and ends at the MGM Grand Station. Trains arrive every 4 to 8 minutes. The system is ADA-compliant and wheelchair-accessible, allowing wheelchairs and motorized scooters. Stations are equipped with elevator service to the tracks, and there is level boarding from the platform to the train. Each car has space to accommodate mobility vehicles, and trained service animals are also allowed.

- The Las Vegas tram system is an easy and free way to travel along the Las Vegas Strip. Each station is equipped with an elevator and is fully wheelchair accessible. The service is free. Three trams serve Las Vegas: the Mirage-Treasure Island Tram, the Aria Express Tram, and the Excalibur-Luxor-Mandalay Bay Tram.

- The Regional Transit Commission (RTC) operates multiple city bus lines. All buses are wheelchair accessible, with lowered floors, ramps, and wheelchair securement areas on board. Priority seating is available for individuals with disabilities and the elderly.

Door-to-door service is available for customers who have been evaluated and deemed eligible after an in-person consultation.
